

Directions to 51 Wall Street, Norwalk, CT

From Stamford:

I-95 to Exit 16 (East Avenue). At the top of the ramp take a left onto East Avenue and go 1/2 mile. At the big bank of traffic lights take a left onto East Wall Street. East Wall Street becomes Wall Street. We are at 51 Wall Street on the left with green and beige awnings.

Merritt Parkway to Exit 40A (Main Avenue). Take a right at the bottom of the ramp. Go south on Main Avenue. Main Avenue becomes Main Street, follow to end after crossing Route 1. Turn right onto Wall Street. We are at 51 Wall Street on the left with green and beige awnings.

From Fairfield:

I-95 to Exit 16 (East Avenue). At the top of the ramp take a right onto East Avenue and go 1/2 mile. At the big bank of traffic lights take a left onto East Wall Street. East Wall Street becomes Wall Street. We are at 51 Wall Street on the left with green and beige awnings.

Merritt Parkway to Exit 40A (Main Avenue). Take a right at the bottom of the ramp. Go south on Main Avenue. Main Avenue becomes Main Street, follow to end after crossing Route 1. Turn right onto Wall Street. We are at 51 Wall Street on the left with green and beige awnings.

From New Canaan:

Route 123 South. Take 123 into Norwalk. Follow Route 123 (New Canaan Avenue) under the Route 7 expressway and over the railroad track. At the end of New Canaan Avenue, take a right onto Main Street staying on Route 123. Go south on Main Street, crossing Route 1, and follow to its very end. Turn right onto Wall Street. We are at 51 Wall Street on the left with green and beige awnings.

Parking

In addition to street parking, there are two parking lots available to David Harvey Jewelers customers. Parking can be found in the Yankee Doodle Garage, located directly across the street from David Harvey. An additional option is the Issac Street Parking Lot located off of Issac Street, behind David Harvey Jewelers, and across from the Garden Cinemas.
